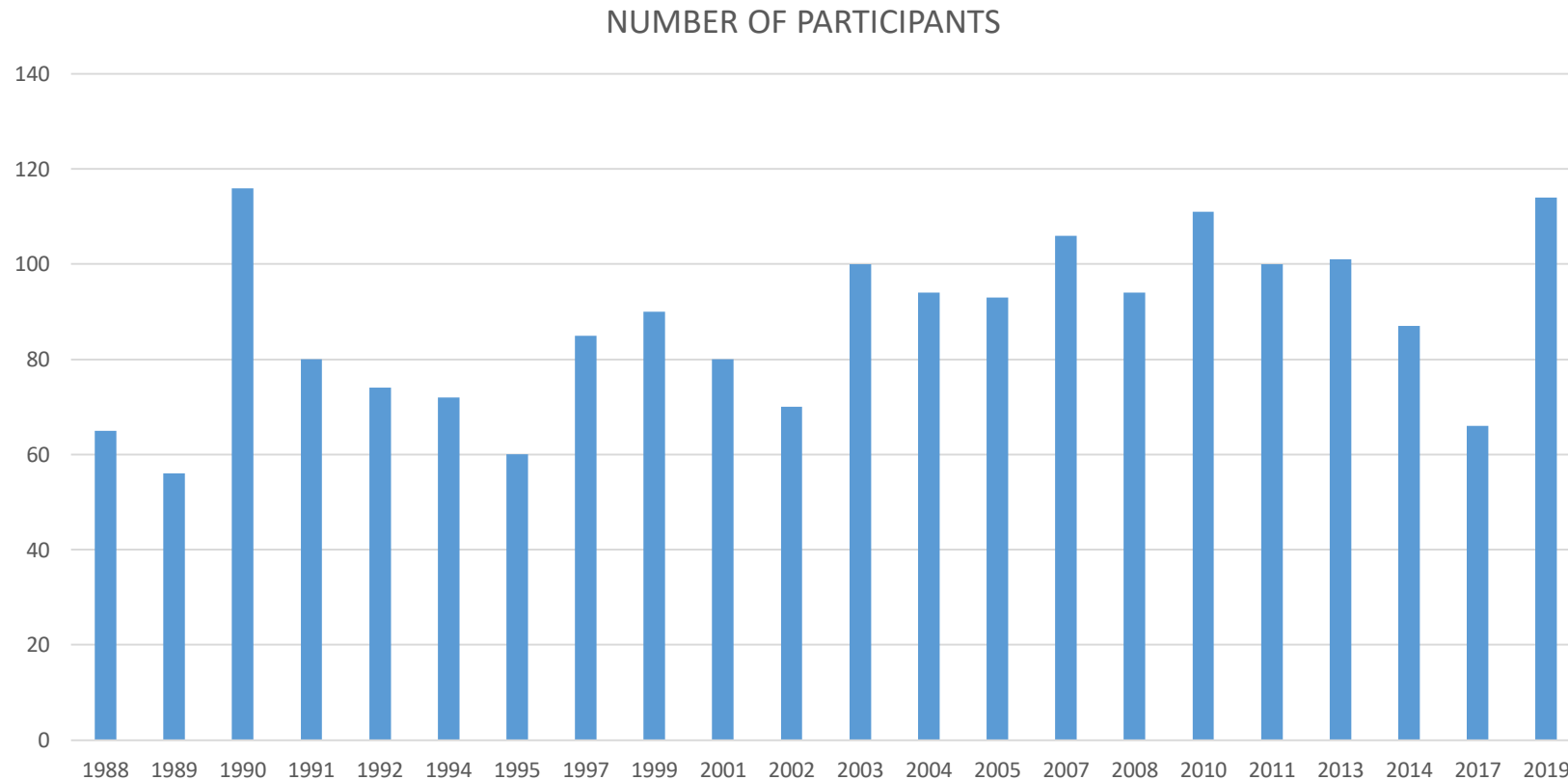


Welcome by the Scientific Organizing Committee

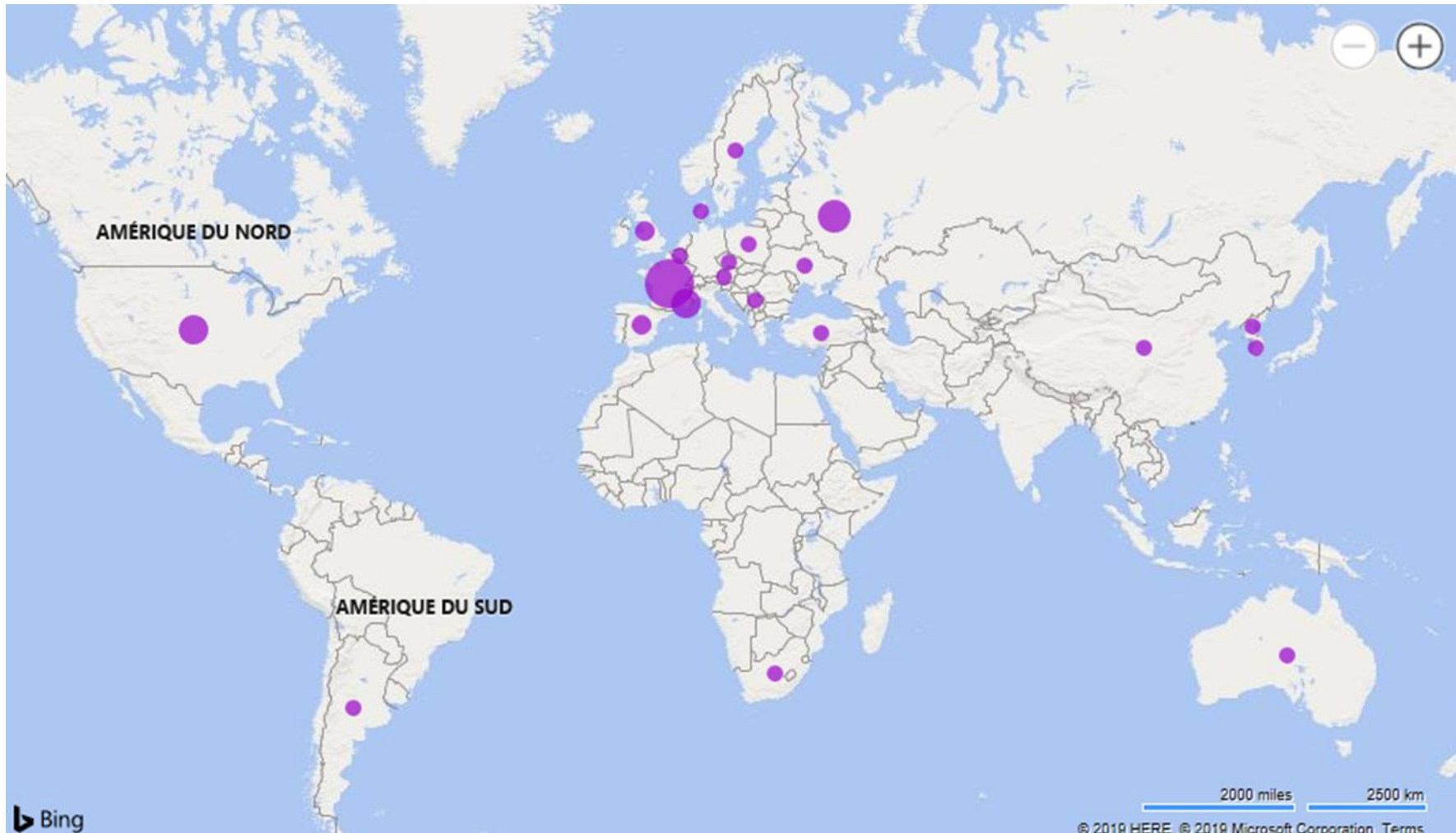
One of most crowded edition since 1988 (114 attendants)
